DISINFECTION OF BAUWERK PARQUET

Floors without frequent hand and skin contact do not require additional disinfection. Normal maintenance cleaning is sufficient for the parquet surface. Due to their natural ingredients, wooden floors already have good antibacterial properties.

The RKI writes about this: Recommendation of the Commission for Infection Prevention from the Robert Koch Institute (RKI): "For surfaces without frequent hand or skin contact, routine disinfection can be dispensed with."

If you as a user still want to use a disinfectant, you must take care not to damage our surface coatings. Due to the large number of disinfectants available on the market with the most diverse ingredients, it is impossible to give a general resistance of the sealings to disinfectants. Disinfectants based on alcohols and acetates are generally suitable. Disinfectants can cause damage to surfaces that are not intact.

Disinfection can be useful where skin contact with the parquet floor cannot be avoided, e.g. day-care centres, wellness areas or even in hospitals. Special disinfectants are available on the market. These must be used according to the manufacturer's instructions. We recommend a not too frequent and damp application, you are welcome to coordinate this with the application technology of Bauwerk.
