In new buildings, kitchens are often integrated into an open living/dining room. An uninterrupted parquet floor stretching from the kitchen area to the living area often emphasises the generous architecture of the room.

There is a trend towards simple kitchen designs in unobtrusive colours, such as hues of white and grey – timeless is the word of the hour. The natural wood colour and grain of a real wooden parquet floor provide an attractive contrast to sober modernity and create a comfortable atmosphere.

Which parquet is suitable?

Parquet in the kitchen should always be hardwood, for instance oak, which hardly shrinks or swells in humid conditions.

The right parquet care

Swiftly remove spots and puddles and wipe the floor dry. Always wipe the floor with a humid mop as too much water could damage the wood. Avoid aggressive cleaning agents. Suitable parquet care products are available at our online shop.

In the case of oiled parquet floors, annual or bi-annual re-oiling (depending on wear and tear) will preserve the beauty of your kitchen parquet for many years.
