
visually, but also enhances an overarching concept of sustainability.



Even today, our main facility in St. Margrethen, Switzerland, remains the technological centrepiece of our work, a competence centre and production site responsible for creating over 60 % of Bauwerk Parkett's product range with passion, precision, and reliability.

Precise and smart

Having invented solid parquet in 1935, Swiss pioneer Ernst Göhner laid the cornerstone for creating Bauwerk Parkett. Over 90 years later, our dedication to perfection still drives our thinking and actions. We strive to make it possible for our clients to experience Swiss precision in all our products.

Our promise: We are precise in everything we do and deliver premium quality that always stays true to Swiss craftsmanship and tradition. With the latest technology and an ambitious design philosophy, we develop smart solutions and groundbreaking innovations that continue to revolutionise the industry.

FOR THE LOVE OF NATURE

For us, sustainability is not a trend but a company philosophy we pursue through our work. As part of this, we consistently emphasise wood as a naturally renewable raw material. Wood is a lasting, durable, versatile material that can be completely recycled, and each piece is unique. Unlike other materials, wood stores large quantities of CO₂. We are privileged to use this fascinating natural product to make parquet floors.

Living and healthy material

98% of our parquet is wood, an organic material that comes into being through unique living processes in nature. Simply put, wood just needs sunlight, air and water to grow. Compared to other types of flooring, manufacturing parquet is very energy-efficient because we effectively 'only' need to shape the raw material that nature has already given us. Most of the energy is used for drying the wood, and we even manage to keep this process CO₂-neutral as we reuse waste wood.

Manufacturing parquet involves other materials besides wood, such as adhesives, lacquers, and oils. At Bauwerk Parkett, all these components meet our high '100 % healthy living' standard, which is confirmed by independent bodies, including the strict requirements of the eco-INSTITUT label.



Lasting for generations

With regular care, wooden floors are highly durable, boasting incredible longevity, allowing them to last for decades. Nevertheless, life tends to leave its trace on everything, and parquet is no exception. Compared to many other types of flooring, authentic wood floors have a decisive advantage: you can touch them up, partially repair them, or even wholly sand them off. This means that parquet can be a timeless and lifelong companion for your home: renewable, repairable and capable of preserving its value for a long time.

Controlled origin

'Sustainability' is originally a forestry term referring to a method for managing a forest whereby consumption does not exceed what nature can produce. For our parquet, we only use wood from controlled forestry sites. All our production sites are FSC®-certified, and we consistently work towards increasing the share of FSC® or PEFC®-certified wood. We try to keep the supply routes for wood as short as possible. Hence, we procure 97% of the wood (oak, beech, etc.) from Europe, and only 3% comes from North America (walnut and maple).

Our contribution to a better quality of life

Only parquet can have such a positive effect on the entire impact of a room and, therefore, our well-being. And we would like to bring this feeling to organisations that need it. Every year, through our Parquet Magic campaign, we support charity projects by donating parquet for a good cause. As a brand, we wish to continue the charitable activities carried out by our founder, Ernst Göhner.



MASTERING MATERIALS


As a wood-processing company, we always feel obligated to treat the resources available to us in a sustainable, forward-looking and responsible way. Bauwerk Parkett took up the task of research and development in wood technology as early as the beginning of the 1950s. Thus, for example, Bauwerk Parkett became not only the first parquet producer but also the first company in the world to certify its entire production facility as compliant with life cycle principles.









Originally built as lodging for military personnel, with a low roof and many small rooms, this bungalow in Berlin was converted into a modern three-storey villa. The atrium in the heart of the house was developed to create a balance between intimacy, openness and connection. This centralised arrangement enables fluid transitions between the different areas of the house and provides a direct connection to nature. Thus, special attention was also placed on using natural, high-quality materials in the living areas.

Discreet elegance

Natural materials and high-quality surfaces define the interiors' aesthetics. The solid wood structures on the walls and ceilings were left exposed, combined with parquet floors and matching stairs, creating a cosy atmosphere, which balances well with the view of the lush trees outside the large windows. The Silverline Edition planks are made of particularly straight, carefully hand-picked oak trees. The cut of these planks creates fine, straight longitudinal lines in the grain, which is a feature that represents exclusive quality.







The film production company moved to its new office space in Zurich's Binz district in summer 2024. Over the last few years, the former industrial estate has been transformed into a lively, creative quarter. The architects from balbek bureau left many of the indoor surfaces in a refined raw state, with a great deal of exposed concrete and sanded cement screed on the floor. In contrast, the central lounge area, used for team meetings and relaxation, is deliberately made to stand out with its warm parquet floor.

A lively space for work


The creative Spinpark floor collection was used to design the surface. Laid in a classic shipdeck pattern, this 40-square-metre authentic wood floor surprises with its unusual and dynamic presentation. This is achieved thanks to the diagonal orientation of the grain relative to the planks. With the grain of the wood at 45° relative to the plank, Spinpark, developed by the Swiss architect and design firm atelier oï, offers completely new possibilities for floor aesthetics.

Nature's work of art

Spinpark provides a perfect setting for the lounge area at Dynamic Frame's new office. The rectangular parquet area has an aspect ratio of 4:3. balbek bureau has used this reference to the classic image format on many office surfaces, reminding the viewer of the film production company's work.







A historic villa near Geneva underwent a comprehensive and energetic renovation that treated the building's existing volumes respectfully and aimed to preserve its authentic character. The architect, Charlotte Nierlé, chose the large 1-strip planks of the Villapark format to create a cosy atmosphere in the living spaces.

Respecting the original

The indoor spaces are characterised by the extensive presence of exposed concrete in wall surfaces, room dividers and stairs, as well as armchair and sofa pedestals, underscoring their minimalistic nature. A parquet floor was used to visually separate the lower-lying living spaces from the rest of the ground floor. Here, the architect deliberately chose the Villapark 1-strip-planks. These large, 2100 × 190 mm planks have bevels on their long sides, further emphasising their dimensions. The light-coloured oak offers a worthy frame for the furniture Edouard Nierlé, the architect's grandfather, designed for this house himself.







The tradition-rich Hotel zum Hirschen has belonged to the same family since 1830, as its members have spent centuries turning it into the prestigious Salzburg hotel that it is today. The Richter-Wallmann couple, representing the family's 11th generation, took over the property a few years ago, bringing innovative ideas and a holistic view of nature and people. This project demonstrates impressively how existing buildings, new buildings and high-quality outdoor and greenery design can be combined in a sustainable overall concept within an urban environment.

Modern timber construction meets tradition

The historical hotel building and its 106 rooms and suites underwent careful renovation. Indoors, you can feel the charm of bygone times, while the design also offers linear, purist elements with select natural wood and green colours, elegant furniture and lights, and refined details made of bronzed brass. It is only natural that in selecting the flooring, the owners and the architects went for a sustainable, high-quality product.

Parquet for a harmonious result

In the hotel rooms, a cosy atmosphere is created by the natural oiled, deep-brushed oak planks from the Cleverpark 1250 collection, in the Oak Farina colour. In the lobby and dining room, the hotel's guests are welcomed by a warm-coloured, slightly brushed strip parquet from the Unopark series, laid in a herringbone pattern, which offers a refined, high-quality stage for the space's modern, linear interior.




CREATIVE FREEDOM

Just like nature itself, parquet is a master of transformation. Subtle changes in the wood's features, colours, formats, and, most of all, laying patterns make parquet synonymous with diversity that knows no bounds.





The idea is irresistibly simple, and despite that, no one had thought of it before. Being unique and simple the 3:1 and 2:1 proportions of its planks, **Formpark** can be laid in both a parallel and an orthogonal pattern, creating architecturally inspired patterns and maximum design freedom.




Individuality and diversity of form

With Formpark, diverse patterns emerge, from calm to lively, from classic to avant-garde, based on the way the parquet is installed and how light falls on it. Smooth transitions from one pattern to another are also possible. The person who came up with this brilliant idea is Stephan Hürlemann, an architect and designer from Zurich, who developed the exclusive authentic wood floor for Bauwerk Parkett together with the designer Simon Husslein. This floor represents a departure from modern style, and thanks to its individuality and diversity of form, Formpark always brings a contemporary look to wherever it is used.










More creativity for smaller spaces
The further development in the Formpark Mini
format also enables countless variations
of patterns and floor typologies with a lot of
space for custom design. Thanks to its
small dimensions, it creates powerful looks even in smaller rooms.





Multifaceted and striking

Thanks to the 5:1 dimension ratio of its planks, Formpark Quadrato can be adapted to many different floor designs. Therefore, in addition to classic herringbone, in which the planks lie at a right angle to each other, other geometric patterns are possible, like the cube or ladder patterns. The format presents a clear, structured aesthetic, and depending on the arrangement, can give the room more depth.









Reinterpretations of classic patterns
Thanks to the 45° angle of its individual strips,
Formpark Rombico is perfect for laying parquet in a French herringbone pattern, also known as chevron. This pattern is formed by the individual strips of parquet creating a set of diagonal lines that give the room a new perspective. The large dimensions of the individual planks make it possible to reinterpret other laying patterns as well, whether you prefer more explicit shapes or are looking for a dynamic zig-zag design.





A play on natural diagonals and a metamorphosis of forest to parquet: the concept of **Spinpark** is down-to-earth and simple. On the other hand, the close interconnection of nature and the craft of laying parquet, paired with a new cutting technique, brings out a completely new space for creativity in flooring. It offers unique visual compositions that are a fitting match for the versatility of wood as a material.

Inspired by Nature

In developing this new authentic-wood floor product, Bauwerk Parkett collaborated with the renowned Swiss architect and design firm atelier oï, which had to work closely with the natural material of wood. Observing nature, thinking with one's hands, and experimenting with materials is an integral component of atelier oï's DNA. Their vision: Good Design. Located on the idyllic bank of Lake Biel in La Neuveville, the Swiss architecture and design studio is surrounded by nature, which is a perfect source of inspiration for projects like Spinpark.

Outstanding design


The principle that makes the format so special is a simple rotation, or a 'spin': with the grain of the wood rotated 45° relative to the plank, Spinpark opens entirely new possibilities for floor optics. The Red Dot Award jury also recognised the benefits of this innovation in parquet design, honouring the achievement with the product Red Dot Award: Product Design 2024.

Large variety of composition options

Depending on the arrangement of the planks, a chevron pattern can be created, which looks similar to the natural structure of a leaf, thus bridging the gap with the origin of the parquet. Spinpark can be laid in parallel and herringbone patterns, offering a large variety of composition options. Special feature: With Spinpark, you can intentionally achieve the popular chevron look even with a parallel installation method.





Facets of light

When designing a space, it is important to consider lighting. The warmth of the light changes our perception of the floor and affects our mood. Cool light can be rather refreshing and invigorating and is preferred in work contexts. Warm light, on the other hand, creates a sense of comfort and builds a cosier atmosphere, perfect for relaxing spaces like bedrooms and living rooms.

Unique interplay of colour

The natural temperature of light changes throughout the day, emphasising the fine features of parquet in its many facets. That is why it is important to consider the room's lighting when choosing a parquet.







The long planks impress with the large variety of classic and creative patterns they can form to design a very personal room experience! The 900 mm **Cleverpark** plank is the longest format in Bauwerk Parkett's product range that can be laid in a herringbone pattern. With its clever 9:1 dimension ratio, it can also be used for many other classic and modern patterns.

Laying pattern and orientation

Shipdeck is the most common laying pattern, in which the planks are offset relative to each other longitudinally. However, more creative laying patterns have been enjoying a remarkable revival for some time: the herringbone pattern with its refined chevron look and other traditional laying patterns are again being used. Once you decide on the laying pattern, there is still the question of whether the parquet will be installed longitudinally, transversally or diagonally relative to the room. In general, we recommend aligning the pattern with the direction of the light.








Designed specifically for the herringbone laying pattern, **Vectorpark** is a perfect timeless classic for what is probably the most popular creative pattern. The format stands out for its attractive selection of colours and large dimensions. Bevelled on four sides, its planks provide a three-dimensional effect, allowing the individual strips to take centre stage.








The manufacture

The used-look surfaces result from an elaborate process that gives the planks their unmistakable character. They are placed in large trays and thoroughly washed with pyramid-shaped stones, following a method similar to how used-look jeans are made. They then undergo a unique staining treatment that adds a distinctive patina and authentic signs of wear to every plank.

What is the difference between parquet and laminate?

Parquet is a high-quality natural product made of authentic wood that impresses with its unique look, feel and sustainability. No two floors are the same, bringing warmth and individuality to the room. At first glance, laminate floors appear so similar to parquet that you can mistake one for the other. This is because of the wood look, which is surface-printed onto decorative paper. The quality difference becomes apparent not only in the feel and the sheen of the product but also in the acoustics: laminate makes significantly more noise when walked on. Unlike parquet, laminate cannot be renovated or reworked, meaning it has a much shorter lifespan.

Can you also lay parquet in the bathroom or in the kitchen?

With the right preparations and care, parquet can work well in a kitchen or a bathroom. Bauwerk Parkett's high-quality, full-area bonded parquet with carefully sealed joints prevents moisture from accumulating under the floor or in cracks. Special water - and dirt-repellent surface treatments are also available. This means that our parquet can easily withstand even small sprays

Do underfloor heating and parquet work together?

Parquet is more than an eye-catching feature in the room: it brings cosiness and warmth, and if combined with underfloor heating, it becomes a very special experience when walking barefoot. Parquet by Bauwerk Parkett is well-suited for installation over both electric and warm-water underfloor heating.

Is parquet a good idea for households with children and pets?

Mishaps are common in homes with children and pets, and parquet must be durable enough to withstand them. Because of its robustness and innovative surface treatments, the high-quality and healthy-for-living authentic wood floors by Bauwerk Parkett are well-protected and forgiving.

Is parquet suitable for people with allergies? An authentic wood floor is a perfect choice for people with allergies because it does not accumulate dust or dirt, thus creating a hygienic environment. Our B-Protect® lacquer prevents particles from attaching to the floor surface, thus simplifying cleaning. Parquet also has antibacterial properties, meaning that it is the best flooring option for households with people with allergies.

Is parquet more expensive than other types of flooring?

At first glance, parquet might seem like a bigger investment. Still, its advantages make up for the price difference: Our authentic wood floors are precision-made to a high-quality standard, with an extremely long lifespan, preserving their natural beauty for decades. Parquet by Bauwerk Parkett will also increase the value of your property: it is an investment that pays off in the long run and brings joy to generations.

Does the colour of parquet change due to sunlight?

Wood is a natural product, and its natural colour takes time to develop. Different types of wood can go darker or lighter, or even change their colour. Smoked wood shows little change in its colour. Floors with Bauwerk Parkett's innovative B-Protect® surface treatment are more UV-stable than other products, retaining their original colour for years.


How costly is parquet to Cleaning and care of various surfaces is easy and uncomplicated. For routine cleaning, it is enough to remove loose dirt with a broom or a vacuum cleaner. A damp mop and a suitable cleaning agent are needed for a more thorough cleaning. Bauwerk Parkett offers appropriate products to suit your floor.

Can parquet be renovated?

Parquet stands out for its robustness. When sanding a parquet, you usually remove $0.5-0.7\,\mathrm{mm}$ from its top layer. This means that any floor by Bauwerk Parkett can be sanded multiple times.


