It is available in six different colours and two surface treatments. All planks in this format come with a calm wood grain and without bevels, resulting in a seamless, cohesive look. This allows the character of the parquet to be fully expressed through the chosen laying pattern.

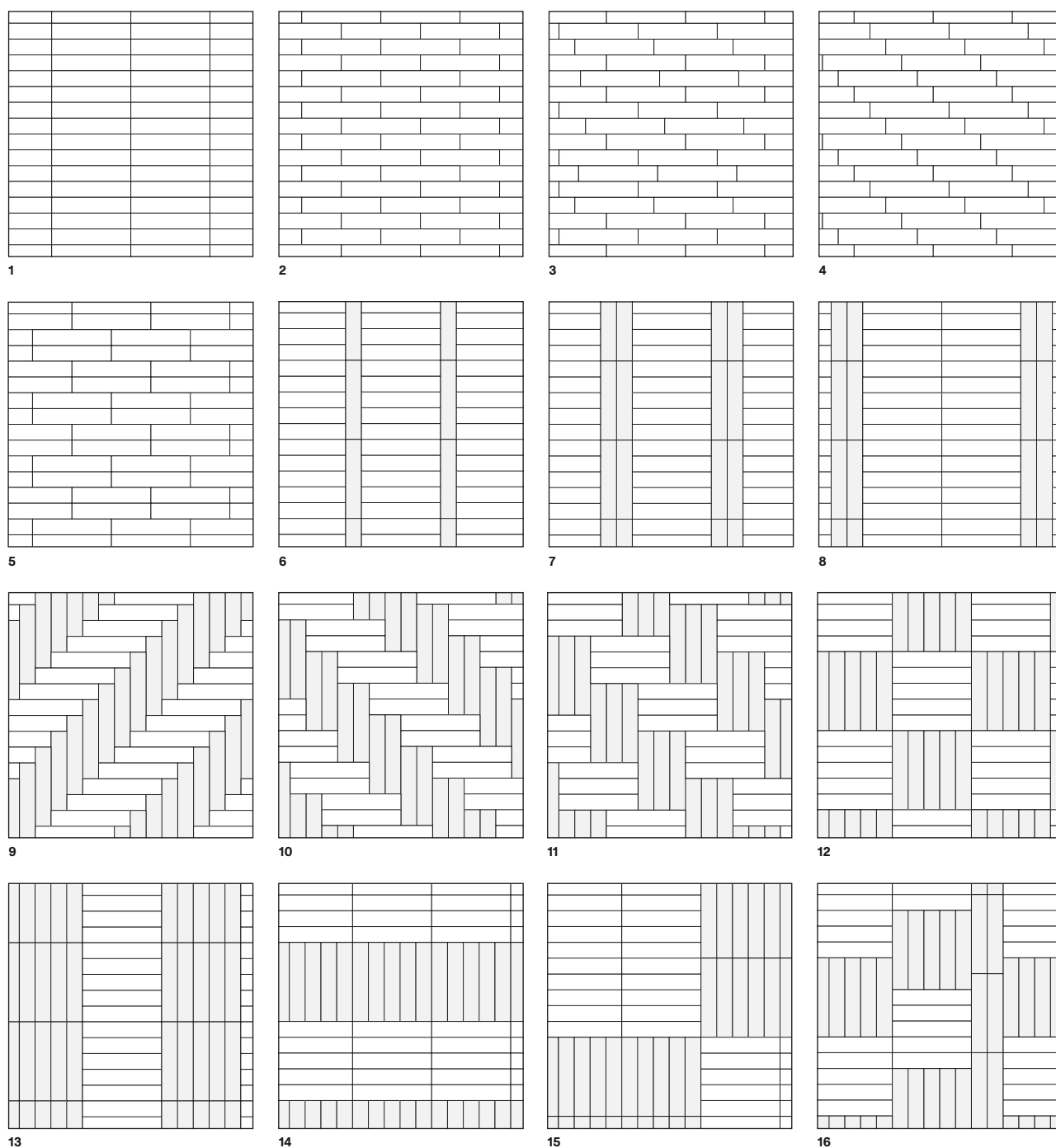

Laying patterns

Thanks to the 5:1 dimension ratio of its planks, Formpark Quadrato can be adapted to many different floor designs. Therefore, in addition to classic herringbone, in which the planks lie at a right angle to each other, other geometric patterns are possible, like the cube or ladder patterns. The format presents a clear, structured aesthetic, and depending on the arrangement, can give the room more depth.
