Formpark Rombico has a 45° angle, among other things, making it ideal for laying in a French herringbone pattern. It is offered in the Oak, Oak Farina and Oak Mandorla shades, brushed, not bevelled. This format is very complex technically, and is manufactured with utmost precision, the latest machinery and unique Bauwerk quality. The dynamic zigzag pattern of Formpark Rombico shines not only in the classic French herringbone pattern, but also with other individual patterns that have a clear form language.
