



The brushed surface enhances the floor's character and depth, further emphasising the interplay with light. The planks of this 2-layer parquet have a calm wood grain and no bevels, creating a seamless appearance.



# Laying patterns

Thanks to the 45° angle of its individual strips, Formpark Rombico is perfect for laying parquet in a French herringbone pattern, also known as chevron. This pattern is formed by the individual strips of parquet creating a set of diagonal lines that give the room a new perspective. The large dimensions of the individual planks make it possible to reinterpret other laying patterns as well, whether you prefer more explicit shapes or are looking for a dynamic zig-zag design.
