Colours, surfaces and dimensions

The 2-layer Vectorpark format, with its 790 × 137 × 10.5 mm dimensions, stands out for its extensive range of design options. The planks come in five tones, varied and very distinctive grain patterns, and three different surface treatments. A bevel on all four sides of the plank creates a three-dimensional effect that visually emphasises every individual strip. The brushed surface brings out the wood's natural structure and promises a memorable tactile experience.
